## Example Payment Schedule

Effective January 2026

This example payment schedule demonstrates how tuition and fees for each program may be structured. Actual payment dates and amounts may vary based on the student's enrollment agreement.

### Cosmetology / Barbering Program

**Total Tuition:** \$18,340

**Application Fee:** \$50

**Deposit Due at Signing:** \$1,800 (applied toward total tuition)

**Remaining Balance:** \$16,490 - includes enrollment fee

1	At Enrollment	\$1,800	Deposit - required to reserve placement
2	Week 4	\$3,297.50	First installment of tuition balance
3	Week 8	\$3,297.50	Second installment
4	Week 12	\$3,297.50	Third installment
5	Week 16	\$3,297.50	Fourth installment
6	Week 20	\$3,297.50	Final installment - must be paid before graduation

Payment Methods: Cash, check, ACH bank transfer or card (5% transaction fee applies to card payments). All payments are payable to: Cambria Academy of Beauty and Wellness. Late or missed payments may incur fees and result in suspension of training until the account is current. Tuition must be paid in full before a Certificate of Completion is issued.

Payments must be made on the first day of scheduled attendance according to the outlined schedules. Example: if the first day of attendance for the student is a Tuesday, their week 2 payment would be due on Tuesday of the second week they are scheduled to attend.

### Nail Technician Program

**Total Tuition:** \$8,240

**Application Fee:** \$50

**Deposit Due at Signing:** \$1,800 (applied toward total tuition)

**Remaining Balance:** \$6,390 - includes enrollment fee

### Important Notes

- Students are responsible for maintaining timely payments as outlined in their Enrollment Agreement.
- Payment plans are subject to administrative approval and must be confirmed prior to program start.
- Any account more than 60 days past due may be referred to collections, with additional fees and costs assessed to the student.
